1. Video - Highlights of Wales

Use your digital skills to create a video highlighting what Wales has to offer. Share these on Seesaw or Google Classroom.

2. Model making

- Infants: (Nursery - Year 2) Using craft materials (paper, scissors, glue, paint, etc.), create a Welsh dragon mask. Once done, explain what the Welsh dragon represents and its significance in Welsh history.
- Juniors (Year 3 - 6) Create a model of a Welsh landmark.

3. Traditional Welsh Baking

- With the help of a parent or guardian, try baking a simple Welsh dish like Welsh cakes or bara brith. Bring into school for your bake to be judged.
