

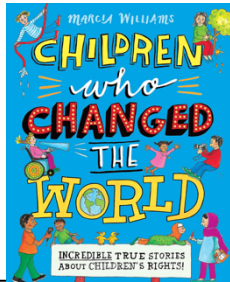
Year 2/3 - Autumn Learning Overview

During the Autumn term, we will be writing:

Health and Wellbeing

We will also be developing our writing by extending sentences and using a range of sentence starters.

We will be exploring feelings in relationships and developing our understanding of safety, communication and recognising the needs and feelings of ourselves and others.

Maths

We will be focusing on addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, developing our fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills.

Science & Technology

We will be exploring people who have changed the world through science and technology. We will investigate forces, movement and gravity through our exploration of space and Neil Armstrong, as well as learning how scientific discoveries such as antibiotics and developments in healthcare have improved people's lives.

Expressive Arts

We will be exploring how art, music and performance can communicate ideas, feelings and messages about people who have changed the world.

We will be looking at bands such as the Beatles and how they revolutionized pop music in the 1960s and Aretha Franklin. As well as looking at artists such as Pablo Picasso.



Humanities

We will explore the lives of important people from the past and present and investigate how they have changed the world. We will learn about figures such as Aneurin Bevan, Betty Campbell, Florence Nightingale and Nelson Mandela, developing our understanding of how people, events and decisions can create change.
