

Wednesday 15th November 2023 Y4 Residential Reminders

Dear parents,

We are really excited about the Year 4 residential to the Urdd Centre in Cardiff Bay tomorrow.

Here are a few reminders for our visit:

- Please come to school between 7:50 and 8:00 am on Thursday 15th November.
- Please park in the car park and bring your child and their luggage to Miss Lewellyn's classroom. You are welcome to stay and wave off your child/children but we ask that the parents wait outside the classroom as we check the children have everything that they need.
- The coach will leave from the layby at 8:15 am sharp and the children will return at 5:30 pm on Friday 17th November. Please be at school at that time to collect your child. If you need another parent/relative to collect your child please email the school office with this information.
- The children need a backpack and an overnight bag with their spare clothes.



In the backpack, the children need:

- 1) A packed lunch
- 2) A water bottle
- 1) A warm waterproof coat
 - The children don't need to wear school uniform but if the children have any Children in Need clothing they are welcome to wear that when we visit the BBC studios on Friday. We suggest all children wear warm clothes, comfortable footwear and trousers appropriate for the ropes course and ice skating i.e tracksuit bottoms.

In their luggage, the children will need:

- 2) At least two sets of spare clothing including underwear.
- 3) A towel
- 4) A sleeping bag (no need to take a pillow)
- 5) Children are allowed to take up to £5 spending money in a wallet clearly labelled with their name.
- 6) A teddy
- 7) Spare trainers/shoes
 - Please write your name in all of your children's clothes.
 - Thursday's evening meal, Friday's breakfast and lunch are provided by the Urdd Centre. The children have already chosen their evening meal in school.
 - Please pack with your child so they know what clothes they are taking.
 - If your child requires medicine it needs to be given to Mrs Jarman-Davies on Thursday morning in a plastic container clearly labelled with the child's name. Parents are required to complete one of the school's medicine administration forms before the visit.
