

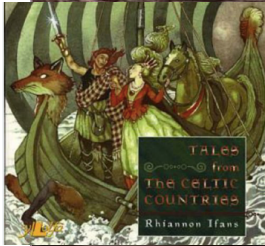

Expressive Arts

- Research and create mosaics in the style from Roman times
- Act out Roman and Celti conflicts
- Create short drama sketches in order gain an understanding of Roman conflicts
- Research, study and sort Roman and Celtic artefacts



Humanities

Within our inquiry pupils will have the opportunity to explore and inspire their curiosity about the world of Celts and Romans in Wales. Through understanding the reasons for the Roman invasion, they will be able to compare, identify and recognise what things changed, the response from the Celts and the influences on society today.

Health & Wellbeing

In Health & Wellbeing we will be discussing how we can communicate our needs in relationships. We will look at feelings in different relationships, communicating these feelings and noticing the needs and feelings of others. Part of this will also be discussing feeling safe in relationships and when we don't feel safe.

In PE we are practising the skills for Invasion games. The children will use a variety of equipment and develop skills in co-operative play.

Computing

During our computing lessons this term we will learn to work together to research, plan, create and refine an online collaborative document. We will then apply these skills to create a presentation.



Inquiry Overview

Our inquiry question this term is
